WHAT IF? POLICIES

...Siblings under twelve months are welcome free but fee paying children have first priority on instruments and equipment.

...Two children over twelve months in a family attending the same class both attract a fee, even if they don't appear to be participating.

...You may join the program in later weeks if there is a place available. Ask for a pro-rata quote.

...Missed sessions cannot be carried over into the next term. You can 'make up' a class at another venue this term.

...Refunds are not given if you simply change your mind and stop attending.

...You and your child contribute to the dynamics of the class. Please contact your educator if you are unable to attend.

...Please notify your Educator if your child contracts a communicable disease.

...Please give your child food and drink before or after the class but not during as this affects the attention of the others.

...Children can be fussy. Please manage your disruptive or crying child. You

may need to take them out of the area for a few minutes to

calm them and allow the others to enjoy the planned activities.

We strongly urge you to return and join in with the group to re-

unite the child with the group.

...Please do not chat but join in and sing! Enjoy

socialising before and after, not during, the class so that your Educator can perform without suffering

voice strain. The children should hear those important words and enjoy your full attention.
